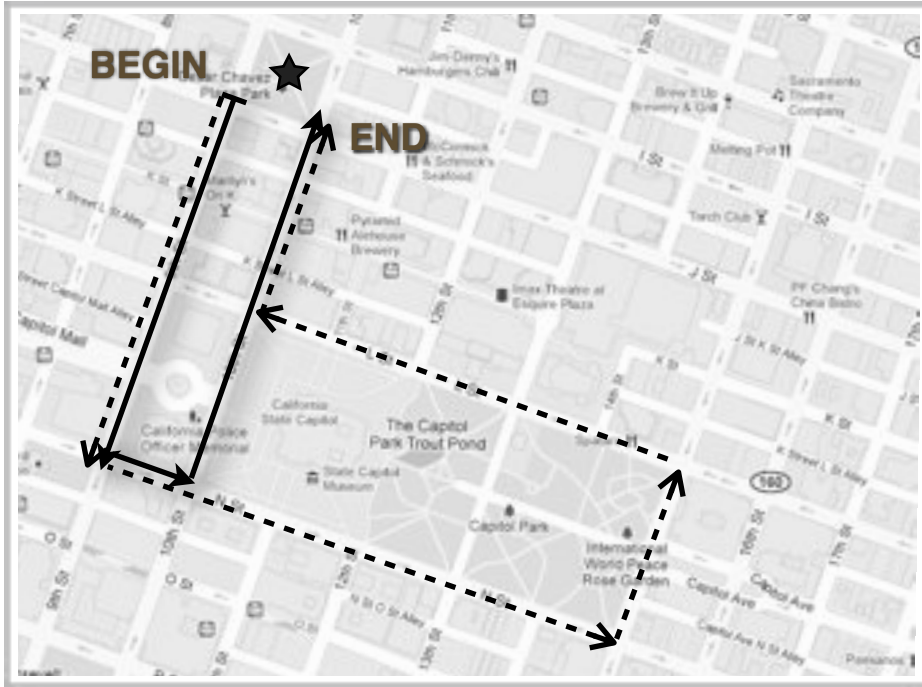


MARCH ROUTE



DIRECTIONS

BEGIN AT corner of J and 9th Street

Head South on 9th St - Follow 9th St

Continue past Capitol Mall -- Watch for SMAS volunteer station

Turn LEFT onto N St

(Continue Route A or Route B)

Dotted ← - - - - | → Solid

ROUTE A: 2.5 miles

Remain on N St

Walk along N St side of Capitol

Watch for SMAS volunteer station

Pick up water / take a break

Turn LEFT on 15th St

Turn LEFT on L Street

Walk 5 blocks along side Capitol

Turn RIGHT on 10th St.

Walk 2 blocks

Finish at Cesar Chavez Park

You made it!

ROUTE B: 1.5 miles

Follow N St for 1 block

Turn LEFT onto 10th St.

Follow 10th St. 5 blocks

Finish at Cesar Chavez Park

You made it!

REMEMBER

WHAT IS HUMAN TRAFFICKING?

Human trafficking (HT) is modern day slavery. HT is the buying/selling of human beings into forced labor or sex. Traffickers use force, fraud & coercion to exploit victims for profit. Victims include men & women of all ages, including children.

WHERE DOES TRAFFICKING HAPPEN?

Everywhere! Contrary to popular belief, HT is a GLOBAL issue affecting every region, in every country across the globe - from Cambodia to the Ukraine, Italy, Brazil and the U.S.

WHAT CAN BE DONE?

By supporting this event and educating yourself on HT you are *already* making a difference! Funds raised through this event will be distributed among 4 organizations combating HT in Sacramento.
